Subject: Unloading point at Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., LPG Bottling Plant at Bodhjunganagar, Tripura – reg.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33 of the Customs Act, 1962 read with Notification No. 40/2012-Cus (N.T.) dated 02.05.2012 (as amended), the area whose details are given in table-1 below, is hereby notified as unloading place for Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) imported by M/s Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. through Srimantapur Land Customs Station; Integrated Check Post (Srimantapur), Tripura subject to their adhering to all laid down procedures for transportation of the LPG and conditions given in table-2, after customs clearance at the Land Customs Station, for unloading at the notified unloading point.

1.	The area of 2094.8 square metre, housing 3 (three) nos. of LPG mounded storage tanks with total capacity of 1350 MT, within the area of Indian Oil Corporation Limited's (IOCL's) LPG Bottling Plant, R.K. Nagar, Bodhjunganagar, PO-Khayerpur, Dist- West Tripura – 799008 and bounded by: South East: TLD shed North East: Product Pump House South West: Open Area (for future expansion) North West: Property Boundary Wall

SI No.	Conditions
1.	The transportation will be done through the proposed route only. (Srimantapur LCS – Boxanagar - Amtali – Khayerpur - IOCL Bodhjngnagar)
2.	Upon filing of Bill of Entry with proper officer at the Srimantapur LCS the entry of vehicles will be done under Car Pass.
3.	On examination of documents and goods as per procedure, Customs clearance will be granted consequent to which the cargo vehicles will proceed to the unloading point under escort.
4.	After unloading, the cargo will return to Bangladesh after due endorsement on the Car Pass.
5.	Movement of Bangladesh vehicles beyond the area of the LCS will be regulated as per the Central Motor Vehicles (Regulation of petroleum products supply to bottling plant in Tripura from Bangladesh) Rules, 2018.
6.	The requirement of passport / visa is under the purview of immigration authorities/MHA and for relaxation of the same, if needed, IOCL may approach the relevant authorities.
